### A Woman from Samaria Comes to Faith From Untouchable to Unstoppable

John 4:1-42

Every society has people who are considered the \_\_\_\_\_ and those who are considered \_\_\_\_\_.

John 4:1-3 *“Now Jesus learned that the Pharisees had heard that he was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John—although in fact it was not Jesus who baptized, but his disciples. So he left Judea and went back once more to \_\_\_\_\_.”*

John 4:4-8 *“Now he had to go through Samaria. So he came to a town in Samaria called Sychar, near the plot of ground Jacob had given to his son Joseph. Jacob’s well was there, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about noon.*

Vs. 4 *“they \_\_\_\_\_ to pass through \_\_\_\_\_.”*

Most Jewish people \_\_\_\_\_ the low caste, half breed Samaritans.

The Samaritans were people who lived in what had been the \_\_\_\_\_ Kingdom of Israel in Old Testament days. Ten Tribes of Israel, \_\_\_\_\_ away from God and were conquered by the Assyrians. . They went into exile and began to \_\_\_\_\_ people of the pagan nations around them.

Vs. 5 Jacob’s well was a religious \_\_\_\_\_ for the Samaritans.

Just because someone is religious, does not mean that they have \_\_\_\_\_ to God.

Jesus chose this place to be a place for a date with \_\_\_\_\_ for the Samaritans.

Vs. 6 *“Jesus was \_\_\_\_\_ from His journey. He sat there to \_\_\_\_\_*

Vs. 7-8 *“When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, “Will you give me a drink?” (His disciples had gone into the town to buy food.)”*

What was wrong with this?

Problem 1. She was a \_\_\_\_\_.

Problem 2. She was a \_\_\_\_\_ This woman was considered an untouchable

Vs. 7 *"Please give me a drink of water."*

Sometimes to open a door for a spiritual conversation it is good to ask for \_\_\_\_\_.

Vs. 9-10 *The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritan) Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you \_\_\_\_\_ water."*

Do not be afraid to tell the \_\_\_\_\_ about God.

Keep the \_\_\_\_\_ in mind.

Problem 3. Vs. 11-19 She was a woman with loose \_\_\_\_\_. Jesus pointed to her \_\_\_\_\_.

Vs. 16 *"Call your husband to come here."*

She had \_\_\_\_\_ husbands and was living with a man.

Before a person can become saved they must \_\_\_\_\_ of their sin.

Vs. 28-29 She repented. *"Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?"*

Vs. 39 *"Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did."*

Vs. 42 *"We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."*

She went from 'Untouchable' to ' \_\_\_\_\_ ' as a witness for Christ.
