Ch. 8:1-13

### REVIEW:

Outline for the book:

1. Chapter 1-3: *Jesus Christ is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the churches.*

The seven messages are good for all churches.

- To those who have lost their first love and become more political than faith based, get back to your \_\_\_\_\_.
- To those who have suffered with satanic \_\_\_\_\_, stay firm, even to the point of death.

2. Chapter 4-20: *Jesus Christ is the \_\_\_\_\_ over the nations.*

Starting in ch. 4: the church is no longer mentioned. The \_\_\_\_\_ occurs at the end of our current church age. All those who are believers in Christ will find themselves, in heaven. Chapter 5: A \_\_\_\_\_ in the hand of God on His throne. The scroll is the title deed of the history of the world. Only \_\_\_\_\_ is worthy to open it. Jesus died on the cross for your sins and for mine. He has purchased the title deed of the history of the world with His blood.

## Chapter 8

### I. A prelude before the judgment

Vs. 1: \_\_\_\_\_ for 1/2 hour: a calm before the storm at the opening of the 7th seal of the scroll.

Vs. 2: The seven angels are given seven trumpets to blow. And when they do, God's \_\_\_\_\_ pours out of them.

Vs. 3 Another angel comes, who offers the prayers of martyrs as \_\_\_\_\_ on the golden altar in heaven. The angel then takes the censer, fills it with \_\_\_\_\_ from the altar and throws it to the earth. The prayers of all the saints are being answered. God's judgments on the wicked are coming.

### II. The first 4 trumpet judgments

#### A. Trumpet Judgment 1 - vs. 6-7

\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ mixed with blood falls from heaven. \_\_\_\_\_ of the trees will burn up along with all the green grass.

B. Trumpet Judgment 2 - vs. 8 Something like a great \_\_\_\_\_ on fire is thrown into the \_\_\_\_\_. 1/3 of the ships will be destroyed. 1/3 of the sea will turn to blood. 1/3 of the sea life will die.

C. Trumpet Judgment 3 - vs. 10-11 A great \_\_\_\_\_ fell from heaven and poisons the water sources with \_\_\_\_\_ - a poisonous sedative. It is always fatal. (Psalm 69:21)

D. Trumpet Judgment 4 - vs. 12 God strikes the stars, sun, moon and planets \_\_\_\_\_ the light by 1/3. You can barely see in the daylight. Panic will result. (Luke 21:25-26)

### III. The passage ends (vs. 13)

"Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth because of the remaining three blasts of the trumpet.

A warning of impending \_\_\_\_\_ is about to take place.
