*Job 19:25-27 “I know that my redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand on the earth. And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God; I myself will see him with my own eyes—I, and not another. How my heart yearns within me!”*

*Daniel 12:2. “And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.”*

*Romans 4:25 “He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification. We are guaranteed to be raised up to heaven because we trust in Christ.”*

*“...his irrevocable victory over death and the grave, and secures both the present salvation and future physical resurrection of believers.”*

*2 Corinthians 5:1-8 “Now we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands... We live by faith, not by sight. We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord.”*

Revelation 1:18 *"I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the \_\_\_\_\_ of death and Hades."*
