### That You Might Believe

John 10:2-5 *“The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger’s voice.”*

John 10:14-15 \_\_\_\_\_ is the Good Shepherd.

He \_\_\_\_\_ them by \_\_\_\_\_.

Vs. 15 *“I lay down my \_\_\_\_\_ for my sheep.”*

Jesus Christ died for you because he \_\_\_\_\_ us.

Vs. 23-25 *“and Jesus was in the temple courts walking in Solomon’s Colonnade. <sup>24</sup> The Jews who were there gathered around him, saying, “How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly.”*

Vs. 25 *“Jesus answered, “I did tell you, but \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ The works I do in my Father’s name testify about me...”*

Everything points to Jesus being the \_\_\_\_\_ Lamb.

Vs. 26-28 *“but you do not believe because you are not my sheep. My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them \_\_\_\_\_, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand.”*

Vs. 31-33 *“Again his Jewish opponents picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus said to them, “I have shown you many \_\_\_\_\_ from the Father. For which of these do you stone me?” “We are not stoning you for any good work,” they replied, “but for blasphemy, because you, a mere man, claim to be God.”*

Vs. 34-36 *“Jesus answered them, “Is it not written in your Law, ‘I have said you are “gods”’? If he called them ‘gods,’ to whom the word of God came—and Scripture cannot be set aside— what about the one whom the Father set apart as his very own and sent into the world?”*

Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_ who has come to you. *“Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, ‘I am God’s Son’?”*

Vs. 37-38 *“Do not believe me unless I do the works of my Father. But if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I in the Father.”*

Vs. 41-42, "Many came to Him... and \_\_\_\_\_ believed in Him there."

So from this passage, what do we know that God does to create faith?

Vs. 7-9 He is the \_\_\_\_\_ through which we must trust the shepherd to follow.

Vs. 10 Jesus "came that they may have life, and have it abundantly".

He is the only means for an \_\_\_\_\_ and eternal life.

Vs. 16, "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be \_\_\_\_\_ flock, \_\_\_\_\_ shepherd."

John 20:31 "But these are written so that you may believe... and that through believing you may have life in his name"

What else does God do to allow you to believe?

In John 14:16-17 "And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the \_\_\_\_\_ of Truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it Vs. 25-28 "These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you..."

John 14:27: " \_\_\_\_\_ I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you..."

Christ's peace= wholeness, completeness and \_\_\_\_\_.

John 14:29 "And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may \_\_\_\_\_."
