The KING of kings and LORD of lords

DEVOTIONALS FOR THE WEEK OF:

December 29, 2024

As we close out 2024, let's dig deeper into who our God is - the eternal KING and LORD of all that is. As you prepare for a new year with new opportunities trust God our King to lead you.

Monday: Luke 1:30-33

When Mary found herself pregnant, who was Jesus' Father? What does this passage say is true about this Son of God? What is so great about Him? What did the Father give to Him as His inheritance? If He owns a throne, what does that mean about Him? Over whom is this King? What does it mean to you that His Kingdom will never end? Today, worship your KING.

Tuesday: Revelation 19:4-10

John who wrote Revelation finds Himself having a vision of what Heaven will be like at the end of time? Who will be there? Many people believe the 24 elders symbolically represent the total number of believers from both the Old and New Testaments based on the total number of sons of Israel and the number of disciples chosen by Jesus. How many tribes and how many disciples chosen by Jesus were there. What were they doing in heaven? Who was seated on the Throne? This is a picture of your future. One day in heaven you will fall down in worship to God your KING. Why don't you spend time today in adoration? He is a great King.

Wednesday: Revelation 19:11-16; Hebrews 10:23; Psalm 33:4

What will the King be riding on when He returns as King? What does white represent? What is His name? Why do we know who is the Faithful and True King? What is the significance of our King being faithful? Explain what it means to hang on unswervingly to our KING. Why is He true? How does that help you? What is the purpose of His return to earth? What does his robe being dipped in blood mean? Why will He be striking down the nations? What is He wearing? Why is He wearing crowns? What does an iron scepter mean to this King? Today, worship this KING of kings and LORD of lords.

Thursday: Revelation 19:16; 1 Timothy 6:15; Revelation 17:14

What is repeated over and over in these passages? What does it mean that Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords? Is there anyone who is over God? Who is the dominant

KING? Is that true even today, or just sometime in the future? What does it mean to you that God has total dominance in your life? Declare Him Lord of you today.

Friday: Psalm 75; Daniel 8:3-9

Who has determined when world leaders rise and fall? Horn in the Bible means political power/strength. Why does God raise up leaders over nations? What is true of a king, world leader who oversteps the boundary that God has established? Today pray this passage over those who carry much political power.

Saturday: Isaiah 40:12-14; Revelation 2:27; Luke 19:38; John 19:19-21

Is there anyone greater than God? Anyone His equal? Why is God so much greater than any political leader? Why did people acknowledge Him as King on Palm Sunday? What did Pilate have nailed to the cross that Jesus hung on? He is a real king? Who will be making war against this KING? What will happen to all who try to dethrone Him? Today, praise your KING. Don't just say He is King. Make Him Lord of your life by choosing to obey Him when He tells you to serve Him in 2025.
