Faith is the Victory Promises of Faith

DEVOTIONALS FOR THE WEEK OF:

July 14, 2024

Can you count on God to answer His promises? This week we dig deeper into the promises that God makes in His Word.

Monday: John 14:1-12

Why should we not be troubled in our hearts? What is promised to you in faith? If that huge gift is waiting, is there anything that is smaller that God is unable to handle? What is troubling you right now? Why can you trust God in this?

Tuesday: Psalm 50:1-12; Haggai 2:8-9

What promises are made in these two passages? Who owns everything that is created in this world? Why does God own it all? What sort of power does He have over creation? What is significant about Psalm 50:10? What might that mean to you in your needs? If you are not at peace because you are in dire need today, ask God to bring peace by using His resources to meet the need.

Wednesday: Exodus 15:26; 1 Peter 2:24; James 5:14-15; 2 Corinthians 12:9-10

What promises are made in these verses about God? What is your belief about God being a healing God? Who wasn't healed of his infirmities? Was he a man with a strong faith? Why does God sometimes heal and sometimes not? Why is it inappropriate to think that an unanswered prayer is a lack of faith on your part? If He does not heal you physically, what other ways might He heal you? Today, thank Him for maturing you even in the midst of adversity.

Thursday: Isaiah 35:4-6; Revelation 21:4

When will all sickness and harm ultimately be dealt with? What will that day be like for you? Why should we fear not while here? Today, spend time thanking God that He has your life in control. Thank Him for those areas that need healing. Thank Him that there is nothing beyond His control in your life.

Friday: Joshua 21:45; 2 Peter 1:4-5

Are God's promises only for Israel? If they are for anyone who belongs to Him, what does this verse mean? Have any of His promises been wrong or unfulfilled? What are

some great and precious promises that He has made for you? What promises is God asking you to respond to today? Whenever you find a promise made by God to His followers, respond to it. Ask God to fulfill it in your life.

Saturday: 2 Corinthians 1:20

What is true of God's promises? Who do they point to? When God is pointing to Christ with a promise, what should be our response? Are there areas where you are not willing to say 'yes' to God in your life? Ponder this today. Why are you reluctant to give God your willingness? Consider repenting of this and give yourself over 100% to the Lord.
