1. The SEALED Servants of God

Four Angels:

Vs. 1 They are standing at the four corners of the earth. They are holding the _____ from blowing.

Vs. 2 They are given authority to _____ the earth.

These are the first four angels who will blow the trumpets of judgement (Revelation 8:7-12)

They are staying still until 144,000 people are _____ for protection by God. This is happening while the 5th seal is broken. The actual harm comes at the opening of the 7th seal.

The Proclamation:

Vs. 3 Do _____ harm. God is _____ His judgement.

Who are the Sealed?

These are a remnant of Jewish believers _____ from each tribe.

This is a literal number because there is no symbolic language here.

Vs. 3 – _____ of our God (see Revelation 6:11).

Vs. 4 – From the tribes of Israel. (Israel is _____ the Church.

The Church does not equal 144,000. The term Israel never refers to Gentiles.)
