- 6. God promises to be with you (Joshua 1:5,9)
- 7. God promises to protect you. (Psalm 91:2)
- 8. God promises freedom from sin. (1 John 1:9)
- 9. God promises that nothing can separate you from Him. (Romans 8:38-39)
- 10. God promises you everlasting life. (John 3:16)
